We are committed to creating a safe and welcoming learning environment for everyone who attends Alpha. To that end, we have the following expectations for all Alpha students:

- 1. Students should be on time to required lectures, and are expected to respect our guest speakers by paying attention. Students should do their very best to participate in all required workshop activities, including writing a story during the workshop and providing their peers with thoughtful critique.
- 2. No recordings of digital lectures, readings, or other students are allowed without prior consent.
- 3. Students are responsible for their own health and safety during the digital workshop. If staff suggest any physical activities or exercises during the workshop, it's up to the student to make sure they don't injure themselves. In the case of a mental health emergency, workshop staff will reach out to the student's emergency contact immediately.
- 4. Discussion during the workshop and content created for the workshop should stay PG-13. Swearing is fine, but descriptions/discussion of explicit sex are not allowed. No discussions of suicide/self-harm or illegal drug use are allowed on the Discord server. When writing or talking about sensitive content (e.g. suicide, abuse, strong violence), we expect everyone to let their fellow students know ahead of time to give them a chance to opt out of engaging with it.
- 5. Harassment on any of the platforms affiliated with the workshop, including email lists, video calls and text-based chats, will be considered unacceptable. We define harassment as any offensive verbal comments, especially related to gender, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, race, or religion; bullying, intimidation, and unwelcome sexual attention.
- 6. Workshop staff are considered mandatory reporters. We are required by law to make a report to ChildLine if we have reasonable cause to suspect that a child is a victim of child abuse.

Participants asked to stop any inappropriate conduct or harassing behavior are expected to do so immediately. Serious misbehavior will be dealt with by consequences up to and including being removed from the workshop.
